COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Literature Depot Carol reported some sales in May. She gave a verbal report of inventory: 6 BRB, 2 12-Step workbooks, 1 Strengthening My Recovery, 10 Laundry List workbooks, 4 Loving Parent Guidebooks and 16 Newcomer Booklets. The only book with a price increase at WSO is the BRB (\$21 for hard cover, \$20 for soft cover). The cost of paper and price of printing have gone up considerably while WSO prices had been steady for several years.
- Website/Zoom Committee –Evie demonstrated the new 'contacts' section at the bottom of the home page, which has hyperlinks for the key contact emails (general and committee chairs). She also showed the partial archive of Conscious Contact newsletters, and showed the June website hits report. Carol has begun writing step-by-step guides on how to do maintenance functions, including posting a flyer, updating a meeting, posting an event. Documentation is stored on our Google Drive.
