 - o Interest in attending will be requested on workshop survey
- Workshop poll from members?
 - o 4 workshops held last year with Shari overseeing
 - o Discussion was held regarding workshop survey to request co-travelers' workshop topic preferences
 - o Survey should also include quarterly speaker meeting preference whether in person or zoom
 - Survey will also ask co-travelers about their interest in attending a retreat Shari mentioned there might be more interest in a one-day retreat
 - o Survey to be sent to IG reps to present to their meetings and also on website
 - Carol volunteered to prepare a draft workshop survey to be presented at next intergroup meeting
 - \circ Shari volunteered Evie to present her Inner Child workshop and Carol to present her Boundaries workshop
- Intergroup Open house 5 year anniversary?
 - Thought process around having a 5-year anniversary celebration similar to first year celebration held at Scotts Valley Water District
 - Shari said she would consult with Renee and Beverle who were instrumental in the first year celebration
 - Suggested timeline of August or September



NEW BUSINESS – CONT'D

- In person/hybrid Speaker meetings
 - Discussion was held regarding making this an in-person or hybrid meeting.
 - Shari is the Chair and coordinates these meetings and can only attend virtually
 - o These meetings are listed on the WSO website and the IG website and attracts attendees out of the area
 - Speakers are recruited out of the area
 - Various meeting sites discussed including Scotts Valley Water District and Center for Non-Violence (where the potluck meetings were previously held)
 - Zoom equipment and need for designated person to handle was mentioned including whether there should be a budget line item to pay for these services
 - Shari suggested it continue to be a zoom meeting since attendees come from all over the country
 - Consensus was this can be done in person as a hybrid maybe for the next speaker meeting on July 16 locations to be researched and this put on next month's agenda
- Move meeting to a new time/day?
 - o Previously discussed in earlier IG meetings but deferred until new year IGs were voted in
 - Day jobs prevent participation if scheduled during the week
 - Straw poll taken Who would be available 4:00-5:30 on Saturday Unanimous in favor
 - Consensus was to put this on the next meeting's housekeeping agenda
 - Evaluation of today's meeting Paul added to the agenda
 - One member felt the meeting was very well run
 - One member said what came up was participant was triggered in the beginning of the meeting and her codependence was triggered and she was very happy that the person could tell their truth
 - One member felt it meeting very well run and there was logical thinking
 - One member thanked the group for learning new roles and we are settling in
 - One member reminded us we are trusted servants we do not govern
 - Jeannie mentioned it was typical to have drafted minutes sent to members who would be interested in looking at the drafted minutes and to provide revisions
 - o Paul asked who would be interested in receiving draft minutes
 - o Paul, Shari Lorna and Carol will receive the minutes and submit revisions to Jeannie
