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- Website was taken down being taken down for maintenance on May 31<sup>st</sup> from 1:00-4:00 pm
- July website graph revealed the most hits were on the day of the speaker meeting, 7/16 116 hits , Best Overall 7/11/2020 327, cumulative total 108,356 since 2018. 2021 was the year with most hits; zoom meeting links are a common reason for people to visit the website.
- Web committee meets 1-3 times per month; Carol does day-to-day maintenance.

### **Quarterly Virtual Speaker Meeting - Shari Chair**

#### Workshop Coordinator – Bob

- Bob reported the venue for Evie's upcoming workshop on Non-Dominant Handwriting is the Resource Center for Nonviolence, Community Room, Saturday August 19 1-4pm. Cost to Intergroup is \$125 of which \$50 is a refundable deposit if the room is left in good condition.

- Question came up wondering if Resource Center for Non-Violence is a hybrid-friendly venue.

- Confirmed IG treasurer will reimburse for postage.
