

ACA Monterey Bay Intergroup Committees

Workshops committee coordinates workshops, either in-person or on zoom. Past workshops have been on Non-dominant Handwriting for the Inner Child, Boundaries, Grief, Loving Parent Guidebook, Step Study, Laundry Lists Workbook.

Quarterly Speaker Meetings lines up 3 speakers and some kind of entertaining short game for each quarterly meeting. These have been zoom for the past 3 years but may move back to in-person to include a potluck. At each speaker meeting the newest newcomer is offered a piece of literature of their choice from our literature depot.

Retreat committee did a lot of pre-Covid work planning a retreat that ended up being postponed and eventually cancelled because of Covid. A refreshed Retreat Committee may work on planning something for 2024.

Outreach committee has developed flyers to post in public places, with tear-off tags listing our acamontereybay.org website and the adultchildren.org website. They created a Spanish-language one pointing to meetings in Spanish on adultchildren.org.

Hospitals and Institutions committee works with county jail and potentially other residential facilities to schedule and lead meetings in the facility for residents.

Literature purchases literature from ACA World Service and keeps them in our 'literature depot' for sale to our member meetings; we pass on our discount pricing to the meetings, who can then set their own prices.

Website committee maintains our website, acamontereybay.org, updating the information on meetings in the Santa Cruz County and Monterey County areas, updates an events calendar, posts flyers about events and workshops, posts agendas, minutes and reports from Intergroup meetings.

Other Service: World Service Organization (WSO) Representative
