

Repricing methodology

After Intergroup formed, we decided to pass on our discount benefit to our member meetings.

Periodically we re-price our books because WSO raises their prices and shipping costs change.

This includes weighing the components of a shipment to allocate shipping costs.

We round our prices up to the nearest 25 cents for ease of calculation for sales.

In October 2024 we ordered **A New Hope** for the first time, which requires figuring out what our price needs to be.

The others haven't been revised for a while so this will align with new shipping costs.

Also including actual sales tax in this calculation for the first time. Sales taxes are based on item's list price.



I went to the Crafts Room. Nice to have free unscheduled quiet time outside the classroom setting.



Well, it went much better than I expected. Very important subject matter, treated with great respect.



I enjoyed the area; although at the end of summer it appeared hot, dry and baron. The seating arrangements were well thoughtout so we all could see & be heard.


